



# FRUIT TREE VARIETIES

## **GALA APPLE**

An early-ripening, sweet and tangy apple. It is self-pollinating, but pairs well with Honeycrisp for a higher yield.

## **GOLDEN DELICIOUS APPLE**

True to its name, this is a delicious fruit - good for baking, preserving, or eating fresh. It is self-pollinating, but pairs well with Honeycrisp for a higher yield.

## **HONEYCRISP APPLE**

A crisp, sweet, and well balanced apple. It is self-pollinating, but pairs well with most other apple varieties for a higher yield.

## **STATE FAIR APPLE**

All-purpose apple that is lively and tart. Pollinates well with Winecrisp.

## **WINECRISP APPLE**

Bred at the University of Illinois, Winecrisp is juicy with full, spicy flavors and a good storage life. Pollinates well with Honeycrisp and State Fair Apple.

## **MONTMORENCY TART CHERRY**

A tart cherry ripening in June.

This cold hardy variety is self-pollinating.

## **NORTH STAR CHERRY**

Large, tart fruit that is great for pies. This variety is self-pollinating.

## **D'ANJOU PEAR**

A multi-purpose pear good for canning, freezing or fresh eating.

Requires another Pear for pollination.

## **RED HAVEN PEACH**

An early peach with red and golden color. It is self-pollinating but higher yielding with other peach nearby.
